### **Nature Trails**

#### **Monomoy Wildlife Refuge**

Chatham is a mecca for bird enthusiasts. In autumn, Cape Cod is a veritable tap for birds of numerous species. Its temperate climate attracts many birds through the winter when most have winged south. The summer months see the migration at its height. Chatham, with Monomoy Island, affords unexcelled opportunity to observe many species, both rare and common. Nearly every species recorded from New England has been seen at some time in this area. The Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge is a link in the chain of migratory waterfowl refuges along the Atlantic Flyway

**Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary** - Wellfleet Bay's 1,100 acres of salt marsh, sandy beach, pine woodland, freshwater pond, and rare heathland attract a wide array of wildlife, especially songbirds and shorebirds. Discover the true nature of Cape Cod as you amble along the five miles of trails that traverse these habitats. The scenic trails are complemented by the Nature Center's green architecture, our friendly volunteers, and a beautiful butterfly and hummingbird garden.

**Cape Cod National Seashore Visitors Center (Eastham)** It is Cape Cod National Seashore's main visitor facility, with orientation movies on the half hour, a well-stocked bookstore, a comprehensive museum and restroom facilities. Just outside the Visitor Center are two popular nature trails. The 1-1/2 mile Nauset Marsh Trail skirts the [Salt Pond](#) and provides vistas of Nauset Marsh and Nauset Spit. The [Buttonbush Trail](#), a shorter 1/4 mile pathway, is a multi-sensory trail featuring a guide rope and text panels printed in large lettering and Braille.

#### **Old King's Highway Tour**

Travel the scenic Old King's Highway: visit a restored sea captain's home, a 1720 cottage and the New Church (built in 1860) while antique shopping along the way. Finish with wine and cheese in one of these antique treasures or at the Cape Cod Museum of Fine Arts. Visit the Sydnestriker Art Gallery and view its famous process of glass making.

**Wood's Hole Oceanographic Institute** - Visitors to WHOI's Ocean Science Exhibit Center will learn about the Institution's ocean science research and the vessels and tools developed by WHOI engineers and scientists for use in that research.

Short videos provide an introduction to WHOI, show a day in the life of the deep submersible *Alvin*, and highlight the 1985-1986 discovery and exploration of the wreck of the *Titanic*. Visitors can step inside a full-size model of the inner sphere of *Alvin* and imagine life at the ocean floor while watching vivid footage taken at deep-sea hydrothermal vent sites. An interactive exhibit features whale and dolphin research and explores the roles sound and hearing play in the lives of marine mammals.

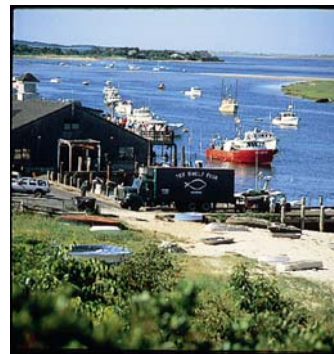
